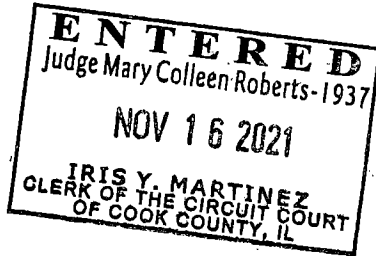
AGREED ORDER – BRIEFING SCHEDULE
