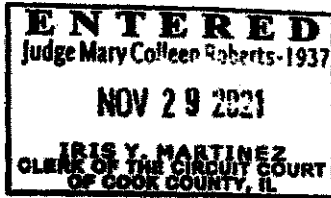
AGREED ORDER – BRIEFING SCHEDULE

- (4231) 1. NAPAA, et al.'s response to the motion is due on December 9, 2021. **THE RESPONSE SHALL NOT EXCEED 15 PAGES.**
- (4231) 2. Allstate's reply (if any) is due on December 23, 2021. **THE REPLY SHALL NOT EXCEED 7 PAGES**
3. This matter is set for clerk status on December 27, 2021 at 9:00 a.m via email. No appearance by parties.
4. Motions for modification of the Briefing Schedule and Extension of Time will not be granted absent good cause and must be filed no later than 2 (two) business days after the brief was due.
- (4734) 5. Allstate shall provide the Court with **ONE** set of courtesy copies of all pleadings **on the day of the clerk status or date directed by the Court.**
6. The courtesy copies shall conform to the following requirements:
 - (a) The courtesy copies shall consist of (a) the most current version of the complaint and any other pleadings pertinent to the motion; (b) Movant's motion and supporting memorandum/exhibits, if any; (c) the response, reply, and supporting memorandum/exhibits, if any; and (d) copies of all

out-of-state and federal case law and statutes.

- (b) The complaint may be provided as a separate copy and not attached as an exhibit to other pleadings.
